Keeping A Holy Lent

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begin on Ash Wednesday, February 23, and ends on Holy Saturday, April 7. Lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word lencten, which means "spring." The season is a preparation for celebrating Easter. Historically, Lent is as a period of fasting and a time for renewal by all Christians. Because Sundays are always little Easters, the penitential spirit of Lent is to be tempered with joyful expectation of the Resurrection. During these 40 Days we will be reflecting on the mystery of Jesus Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. Plan to participating in the following services:

Listen to him!"
