

Baldwin County Sheriff's Boys Ranch:

In 1984, the Baldwin County Boys Ranch was established in Summerdale, Alabama, on land that was donated by John B. Foley, to provide an environment for young men to have a home environment with house parents to live and train up in the way of the Lord. The campus includes two ranch homes, a chapel, gym, pool, office, two staff houses, the boy's college home, and support buildings. The boys attend Foley First Baptist Church on Sundays and Wednesdays. Ranchers attend Foley and Summerdale schools where they participate in activities such as sports, academic clubs, band, and ROTC. Highlights for the year include annual fishing and beach trips, concerts, campouts, church youth activities including mission trips, and cookouts.

Betty & Floyd Replogle Undergraduate Scholarship for LUMC high school graduates:

An undergraduate scholarship for Lillian UMC members 17-25 years of age. The scholarship was started by the church and named in memory of Betty Replogle. In 2020 upon the death of Floyd, the church extended the name to the Betty & Floyd Replogle Undergraduate Scholarship.

Stegall Foundation Seminary Scholarship:

These funds help to financially support certified candidates for ministry from our Alabama West Florida Annual Conference who attend seminary and/or Course of Study.

Teen Challenge of Pensacola, FL:

Teens voluntarily sign a two-year contract. Live in a facility confidentially located in Pensacola. Some recipients are through the court system. Usually, drug-addicted boys and girls.

AL/WF Conference / Pensacola District UMW Support:

These are funds that support conference and district missional endeavors.

Bright Bridge Ministries:

Our local Pensacola District's mission to the Brownsville community providing dignity and welfare to the under-resourced in our community by addressing their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. Their hot and healthy meal service is often a way to introduce those in need to all the services that they offer. Most of their meal clients walk or ride their bikes to the location. They also provide mail service, basic needs, addiction resources, job placement, and other empowering services. In the past three years, we have served over 100,000 hot meals and distributed 3,450 hygiene kits. At least 120 individuals have earned a bike by volunteering at least 30 hours at Bright Bridge.

UMCOR Relief:

The global mission of the United Methodist Church responding to natural disasters and humanitarian crises all around the world.

Embrace AL/FL Kids (UM Children's Home):

Located in Santa Rosa County, FL. A faith-based agency focused on providing homes, healing, and hope to vulnerable children who come from families in crisis and are placed in foster care through no fault of their own.

Shepherd of the Bay (Lutheran Food Pantry):

The Lutheran Church across the street has a food pantry that distributes food locally to those in need.

Kairo's Outside South Alabama:

Spin off of "Walk to Emmaus". When someone is incarcerated, the whole family goes to prison. Many come to Christ through this program!

Red Bird Methodist Mission:

Red Bird Mission, a non-profit agency located in the Appalachian Mountains of Southeastern Kentucky,

empowers individuals and advocates justice by providing educational, health, and community outreach ministries to area low-income residents. They provide K-12 Christian School, Residential Dormitories, Early Childhood Development, provide The Red Bird Clinic, Inc., Community Aid Ministries, Elderly Ministries, Family Ministries, Women and Children Ministries, Community Store, Craft Store & Marketing, Work Camp, Home Repair and Mission Facilities.

UMM – (Car Show Sponsor):

The LUWF support by paying for one of the awards given at the car show.

LUMC Secretary:

The church secretary is cordial to help us with making copies and other work throughout the year and we show our appreciation with this gift at Christmas time.

Family Promise of Baldwin County:

Provides temporary shelter, transitional housing, related services, and nurturing support to families with children experiencing homelessness and assists them with obtaining suitable and permanent housing. Churches host these families overnight and this ensures that families in crisis can stay together as they work toward housing.

Discretionary Fund:
